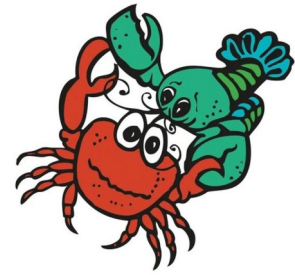

## 2025 Local Charity Grant Information

The Cromer Crab and Lobster Festival (CCLF) local charity grant scheme is open to charity organisations in Cromer and the local area. The grants are given for funding specific projects or for work they would like to embark on.

In the past CCLF has distributed funds to a number of local worthy causes and organisations. This year the 2025 CCLF has raised **£4,000** for distribution under the local charity grant scheme.

Grant applications need to be received by **Monday, 13<sup>th</sup> October 2025**, after which they will be considered by the CCLF Committee at the end of October 2025. Applicants will be advised of the outcome after the Committee meeting. If successful, applicants will be notified and invited to an Awards evening later in the year.

**Grants will only be awarded:**

- To organisations using the official form and who have met the **13<sup>th</sup> October** deadline.
- To organisations which clearly show how their work or project will benefit the communities of Cromer and the local area.
- To fully constituted organisations.
- To organisations that are able to share their financial information with CCLF.

**Please note:**

- CCLF may not be able to award the full amount requested.
- CCLF may ask organisations to supply evidence of how they have spent their grant.
- Further funding in future years will be subject to re-application, as long as the CCLF charity grant scheme is operational.
- CCLF expects that successful applicants will support future Festivals by providing volunteers for CCLF events where possible and taking part in any interaction with the local media.
